

20th Century Chevy, Inc. 2023 Automotive Scholarship

The 20th Century Chevy, Inc. 2023 Scholarship provides assistance in the Daviess, Knox, and Martin, and Pike County, Indiana region to high school seniors or recent graduates attending a post-secondary institution in an automotive related technical or engineering field. The intent of this scholarship is to cultivate an interest in automotive related activities that fosters lifetime learning opportunities and camaraderie among fellow automotive enthusiasts. The scholarship will help support selected students with advancing their collegiate studies and assist in providing a path towards a career in the automotive field.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Be an Indiana resident and high school senior or recent graduate of the following public high schools: Barr-Reeve High School, Loogootee High School, North Daviess High School, North Knox High School, Pike Central High School, South Knox High School, Vincennes Lincoln High School, Vincennes Rivet High School, Washington High School, and Washington Catholic High School.

- or -

Be an Indiana resident and high school senior or recent graduate of any Indiana public or private high school and a participant of the Washington, Indiana Twin Rivers Automotive Vocational Program.

2. Be accepted for enrollment to attend any automotive related technical or engineering field at an accredited (post-secondary) university, college, or vocational / technical program in the United States. The program must grant a degree or certificate in the applicant's educational field. Programs may include but are not limited to the following: automotive technology, diesel mechanics, collision repair, engineering or engineering technology, automotive design, etc.
3. Cumulative high school GPA of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Number & Amount of Award

A single, one-time award of \$2,000 will be provided to the recipient. The award is payable to the recipients selected teaching institution and will be provided directly to the teaching institution. The recipient will be responsible to provide 20th Century Chevy, Inc. with the financial aid office's contact information after scholarship selection.

Deadline to Apply & Award Notification

Applications must be received or postmarked by April 14, 2023. Applications failing to meet the April 13, 2023 deadline will not be considered. The scholarship recipient will be selected by April 21, 2023. The recipient and the recipient's high school will also be notified of selection at this time.

Selection Process

The scholarship committee will consider the following criteria when making a scholarship recipient selection:

1. Statement of educational goals and career objectives in an automotive or related technical field.
2. Signed letter of recommendation from an automotive instructor, career mechanic, science teacher, math teacher, industrial technology teacher, or non-parental member of 20th Century Chevy.
3. General interest in automotive activities such as any variety of racing, vehicle modification and restoration, engine and suspension enhancement, and general involvement & interest in automobiles and the related aftermarket industry.
4. Academic background and achievement.
5. Employment history.
